This is a great location with lots to do in the evening. The room rate is \$94.00 single or double per night. You can make your reservations by calling the Kellogg Center Hotel at 517/432-4000; ask for the MHOEA Conference rate. **Reservations must be made by September 27; our room block will be released after that date.** If you call the hotel after that date you may not get a room at our conference rate. It is suggested that you make your room reservation before September 27, and then cancel if necessary, but you will at least have a reservation. Each year we get many calls a few days before the conference from individuals who waited to make reservations until they received administrative approval, which sometimes only comes a few days before the conference, and they have to pay a much higher room rate or have to go to another hotel. The hotel will not charge your credit card until you actually check in.

The Scholarship Committee will be sponsoring the **Silent Auction**. Remember to bring lots of items for the auction, this year we were able to give 2 scholarships in each region, because of your generosity at last year's conference.
